Call your Representatives and ask them to support

The BRINGING AMERICA HOME ACT

This comprehensive bill is designed to end homelessness in the United States and will include housing, health, income and civil rights components. The proposed legislation represents the most comprehensive initiative to date to address modern homelessness and is based on research, data, and the experience of front line providers and advocates.

Concerned advocates are asked to take the following actions:

- **Call your Representative** (you can ask to be connected through the House switchboard at (202)-225-3121) and tell them that you or your organization is asking them to sign on as an original co-sponsor of the Bringing America Home Act. Have their Housing Assistant contact Michael Wallace in the office of Julia Carson (202) 225-4011.
- **Write** your Representative and ask them to co-sponsor the act.
- **Follow up** any letters and calls with the Representative or an aide and ask whether a decision has been made to support the bill. Reiterate your or your organization's support.

- **Pass** this call to action to as many individuals and groups as possible!
